Dear Parents/Carers,

- **Swimming Gala!!!** Good luck to all the children taking part in the Swimming Gala on Friday (06.07.18). Please meet Mrs Morris outside the Quarry swimming pool in Shrewsbury at 5pm.

- **Sports Day!!!** This will begin at 1pm on Monday 9th July. All events will be races along the track, please bring your own camping chairs/blankets to sit on.
